An Enactment to prevent the improper use of certain emblems, names and titles in the State of Trengganu.

[ ]

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the Legislature of the State of Trengganu as follows :

1. This Enactment may be cited as the Emblems, Names and Titles (Prevention of Improper Use) Enactment, 1976. Short title.
2. In this Enactment, unless the context otherwise requires— Definition.

“specified title” means any title or dignities specified in Part IV of the Schedule.

“specified emblem” means any emblem, seal, flag, insignia, coat-of-arms or pictorial representation specified in the Schedule;

“specified name” means any name specified in the Schedule and includes any abbreviation of any such name.

“competent authority” means any authority competent under any law for the time being in force to register any company, firm or other body of persons, or any trade mark or design, or to grant a patent;

3. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any law for the time being in force, no person shall, except with the written permission of the Ruler in Council—

- (a) use any specified emblem, or any colourable imitation thereof or use any specified name or specified title for the purpose of any trade, business, calling or profession; or
- (b) use or continue to use any specified emblem, or any colourable imitation thereof or any specified name or specified titles, in the title of any patent, or in any trade mark or design; or
- (c) make for the purposes of sale or sell or expose for sale or have in his possession for sale any specified emblem; or
- (d) use any specified emblem, or any colourable imitation thereof or any specified name or specified title as a letter-head or in any card intended to convey greetings to another on any festive occasion; or
- (e) display on or affix to any vehicle any material whatsoever containing any specified emblem or any colourable imitation thereof or any specified name :

Provided that any permission to affix or to display such specified emblems granted by His Royal Highness the Sultan, the Menteri Besar or the Ruler in Council prior to the commencement of this Enactment shall be deemed to have been made under the provisions of this section.

- (f) name or label any road or any building with a specified name or a specified title :

Provided that any specified name or any specified title conferred by His Royal Highness the Sultan, the Menteri Besar or the Ruler in Council prior to the commencement of this Enactment on or to any road, street or any building, if any, shall be deemed to have been made under the provisions of this section.

(2) The prohibition contained in paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of section 3 shall not apply to the recipient or holder or owner of the specified names or specified titles.

(3) The Ruler in Council may subject any permission given under subsection (1) to such conditions, if any, as he may deem fit.

4. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any law for the time being in force, no competent authority shall—
- Prohibition of registration of certain companies, etc.
- (a) register any company, firm or other body of persons under any name; or
- (b) register a trade mark or design which bears any emblem, name or title; or
- (c) grant a patent in respect of an invention which bears a title containing any emblem, name or title;
- if the use of such emblem, name or title would be in contravention of section 3.
- (2) If any dispute arises whether any emblem, name or title is a specified emblem or a colourable imitation thereof or a specified name or specified title, the competent authority shall refer the question to the Ruler in Council and the decision of the Ruler in Council thereon shall be final.
5. Any person who contravenes the provisions of section 3 shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand ringgit.
- Penalty.
6. No prosecution for any offence punishable under this Enactment shall be instituted except with the previous sanction in writing of the Legal Adviser.
- Sanction for prosecution.
7. The Ruler in Council may, by notification in the *Gazette*, add to or alter the Schedule.
- Power to amend Schedule.
