

WHEREAS, WE HAVE, by paragraph 21 of the Statutes, styled the Statutes of the Most Esteemed Royal Family Order of Trengganu (hereinafter referred to as "the Statutes") reserved to Ourselves, Our Heirs or Successors, full power of annulling, altering augmenting, interpreting or dispensing with these Statutes or any part thereof by Notification and signed by Us or Them.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of Our powers under paragraph 21 of the Statutes, WE TUANKU ISMAIL NASIRUDDIN SHAH, Darjah Kerabat Yang Amat Mulia, Darjah Kerabat (Malaysia), Darjah Utama Seri Mahkota Negara, Seri Paduka Mahkota Trengganu, IBNI AL-MARHUM AL-SULTAN ZAINAL 'ABIDIN, Sultan and Sovereign Ruler of the State and Territory of Trengganu Darul-Iman and All its Dependencies, do hereby alter the Statutes as follows—

1. By the insertion of the word "(Sash)" immediately after the word "Riband" appearing in item "(ii) (c)" of paragraph 9 of the said Statutes.

2. Paragraph 13 of the Statutes is hereby amended by the substitution thereof with a new paragraph 13 as follows:

"Insignia to be worn by the Members of the Second Order.

13. Members of the Most Esteemed Royal Family of the Second Order of Trengganu shall wear the Star of the Order of Trengganu on the left side of their outer garments and the Badge suspended from the Riband (Sash) which shall be worn passing from the left shoulder to the right hip."

May God to whom be Praised and Whose name be exalted, the King of Kings, vouchsafe His Grace and may the PROPHET MUHAMMAD (on whom be the benediction and peace of God) grant his blessing to these Statutes for ever and ever.

Amen! O Lord of the Universe.

LAWS OF THE CONSTITUTION OF TRENGGANU

(FIRST PART)

(Article XLII)

STANDING RULES AND ORDERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TRENGGANU

Citation.

Tr. L.N. 17
of 1960.

1. These Rules may be cited as the **Standing Rules and Orders of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Trengganu (Amendment) Rules, 1972** and shall come into force on the 27th day of March, 1972.

Amendment
of Rules 27.

2. Sub-rule (3) of Rules 27 of the Standing Rules and Orders of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Trengganu is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor—

“(3) When the time for asking questions shall have arrived, the Speaker or the presiding member shall call on each member in whose name a question requiring an oral reply appears in the Order of Business of the Day. The member so called shall rise in his place and ask the question by reference to its number on the Order of Business of the Day and the Menteri Besar may give his reply, or any of the Executive Council Members may answer on his behalf.”.

Amendment
of Rule 64.

3. Rule 64 of the Standing Rules and Orders of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Trengganu is hereby amended by adding the words “Bahasa Kebangsaan or the” immediately after the words “be reduced into writing in the”.

4. Substitute the words “Yang di-Pertua Dewan” for the words “Speaker” wherever it appears in the Bahasa Kebangsaan of the Standing Rules and Orders of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Trengganu.
